

With the objective of increasing awareness on the efforts and strengthened cooperation for ASEAN education sector to the challenges of the global health emergency, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the conduct of the Online Poster Making Contest and Essay Writing Contest with the theme: "Transforming Education the ASEAN Way: Forging Partnerships in the Age of Global Disruptions." This is in line with the Philippine Chairmanship's theme of the ASEAN education sector held in Jakarta, Indonesia this year.

The Poster Making Contest shall be participated in by a Grade 5 or Grade 6 student while the Essay Writing Contest shall be joined by a Junior High School or Senior High School student, from public or private schools enrolled this S.Y. 2021-2022. ## PHILIPPINE FOLK DANCE WITH ASEAN INFLUENCES MECHANICS

- Each division shall be represented by four pairs, composed of male and female teachers.
- Participants must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and should observe social distancing at all times.
- Dance piece is Sua-Ku-Sua, a Filipino Indigenous dance that is influenced by the culture of Indonesians and Malaysians.
- Dance is limited only to five (5) minutes including entrance and exit. There will be a
  one (1) point deduction for every minute in excess of the given time.
- 5. Dance literature must be strictly observed.
- Participating division shall submit a recorded entry of their performance in MP4 format.
- Video must be on a landscape orientation and will not change angle/position throughout the shoot.
- Submit the pre-recorded dance video to the assigned google drive per division on or before January 25, 2022.
