- This is to reiterate in all field offices the observance and implementation of DepEd Order No. 37 s. 2022 entitled Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities.
- Also, this office would like to highlight Item No. 6 | Adjustments to Learning Delivery Due to Suspensions/ Cancellation of Classes which states that:

"In the event of cancelled or suspended classes, **modular distance learning**, performance tasks, projects or make-up classes shall be implemented to ensure that learning competencies and objectives are still met."

"In adherence to the provision of DO No. 14 s. 2021, learners who miss learning activities due to class suspensions brought about by various disruptions like disasters and/or emergencies due to natural or human induced hazard shall be accorded due consideration in their attendance and the completion of their learning tasks."
