GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL SEARCH FOR OUTSANDING IMPLEMENTERS OF THE GULAYAN SA PAARALAN PROGRAM

Evaluation Process

- Division Level A ..
 - The SDS shall form a Division Search Committee.
 - 2. The Division Search Committee shall evaluate/shortlist the schools and choose two (2) schools to represent their Division.
 - 3. The Division shall submit the entry schools not later than July 31, 2018, thru the Office of the Regional Director, Attn: ESSD Chief.
- Regional Level B.
 - 1. The Regional Director (RD) shall form a Regional Search Committee.
 - 2. The Regional Search Committee (RSC) shall evaluate the schools and shall choose three (3) winners to be awarded as Regional Outstanding GPP Implementers.
 - The Twenty-Six (26) schools shall present a 10-minute video presentation of their accomplishments with documentation in 3 copies. It shall be presented by the school head or the School GPP Coordinator on August 2018, at the RELC Legazpi City.
 - The RSC will select the Top 3 schools and shall conduct an on-site validation.
 - 5. All entry schools shall receive a certificate of recognition while the winners shall receive a cash prize, plaque and certificates.
 - The results of the evaluation by the RCS is final and unappealable.






