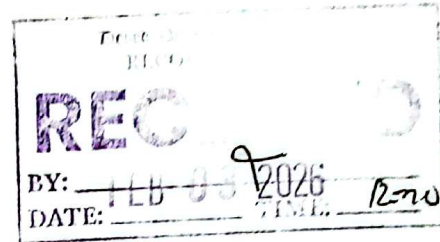

RESOLUTION NO. 11191

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2 of Republic Act No. 12232¹, *the next regular Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections shall be held on the first Monday of November 2026 and every four (4) years thereafter;*

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2023, the Commission En Banc promulgated COMELEC Resolution No. 10924 entitled *“General Guidelines and Other Related Rules and Regulations for the October 30, 2023 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE) and All Succeeding BSKEs Thereafter”;*

WHEREAS, Section 118 thereof provides that *“the Calendar of Activities for the conduct of the Barangay and SK Elections shall be set forth in the resolution to be promulgated by the Commission in connection with the specific BSKE.”* hence, there is a need to provide for the specific period of the same in connection with the November 2, 2026 BSKE;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the Constitution, the Omnibus Election Code, Resolution No. 10924 and other related election laws, the Commission on Elections **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to promulgate the following calendar of activities and periods of certain prohibited acts in connection with the November 2, 2026 BSKE:

This Resolution shall take effect on the seventh (7th) day after its publication in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.
