- 1. The Schools Division Office (SDO) of Catanduanes through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the **2018 DIVISION MATH CAMP Cum PATIRIBAYAN FESTIVAL IN MATHEMATICS** on November 3-4, 2018 for Secondary Level at a venue to be announced later. The activities will be hosted by the Secondary Mathematics Teachers Association of Catanduanes (SMTAC).
- 2. The training camp and festival aims to:
  - a) provide students and teachers learning experiences and opportunities to showcase Math Talents through exhibition of products and performance as evidence of teaching and learning;
     and
  - b) increase teachers and students awareness on engagement to meaningful and appropriate school practices to develop positive attitude towards mathematics trough collaboration.
- 3. Expected to attend the activity are school math club advisers and one (1) key school math club officer and the contestants and coaches for the Patiribayan.
- 4. The allocation of contestants, pre-registration forms, contest guidelines, program of activities, working committees and list of contest administrators/facilities are indicated as enclouse.
- 5. Each participants shall pay a registration fee of One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos Only (Php1, 200.00) to be charged to MOOE/PTA/Club Funds and other sources including their travel expenses subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. The registration fee shall be used to cover the cost of meals and lodging, Check-in time will be 7:00 AM of Day 1 with AM Snack as the first meal and check-out will be 4:00 PM of Day 2 with PM Snack as the last meal.
- 7. Considering that November 3-4, 2018 falls on a Saturday and Sunday, teacher-participants shall be entitled to a two-day service credit in accordance to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.

- 6. Criteria for judging
  - 1. MATH SHOWCASE (Math Games, Puzzles, Student's Device and Teacher's Device) For Elementary/Secondary.
    - a. The participants must be a registered participant of the Division Math Camp cum Patiribayan Festival 2018
    - b. Every contestant shall be given 5 minutes to explain his/her project. However, there will be no time limit for the interrogation portion after the five minutes presentation.
    - c. The decision of the board of judges is final and unappealable.
    - d. The criteria for judging for students' math showcase and Teachers' Teaching Device are the same.
