## DIVISION SKILLS ENHANCEMENT FOR TECHNOLOGY AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION (TLE) TEACHERS

TO: Public Schools District Supervisors
Secondary School Heads
TLE Teachers
All concerned

- In line with the goal of the K to 12 Basic Education Program and the migration of Training Regulations of selected specializations in Teaching Technology and Livelihood Education and for the Teachers to be equipped and be competent in their respective fields of specialization, the Schools Division Office of Catanduanes through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a three-day Live-out Division Skills Enhancement for Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) Teachers on February 7-9, 2019 at the venue to be announced later.
- 2. This activity aims to:
  - a. enhance Teachers skills in Teaching TLE Competencies;
  - equip the participants with the teaching strategies and approaches essential to teaching and learning;
  - c. Prepare teachers to qualify for National Certification being conducted by TESDA;
  - d. share best practices in teaching TLE.
- Secondary school heads are expected to submit the names of participants on or before January
   25, 2019 and should consider the qualifications/specializations listed in the attachment.
- 4. Participants are expected to be at the venue on the first day of the training and they are requested to bring LMs and TGs. Additional training materials required per qualification are found in the enclosure. They are likewise required to bring their own PPE.
- Trainers/Facilitators are advised to report to the EPP/TLE/TVL EPS at the SDO terrace on January 31, 2019, 8:00 AM for final briefing.
- 6. Since February 9, 2019 falls on a Saturday, a one (1) day Service Credit/COC shall be granted to participants, technical/working committees and trainers/facilitators.
- 7. Travel, accommodation, training materials and other incidental expenses of the trainers/facilitators and participants shall be charged to school's MODE while meals (AM snacks/lunch/PM snacks) for three (3) days shall be charged to Division Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. The training matrix, List of trainers/facilitators and working committees are found in the enclosures.
