- 1. In preparation for the upcoming RASSEAE Regional Inter-Division Tournament in various sports this August 2022, this office will conduct a Division Limited Face to Face Tournament in various events on August 1-9, 2022. Attached is the schedule of the tournaments per event for your reference (Enclosure A).
- 2. Generally, the student-athletes should be:
 - born on January 1, 2005, onwards;
 - Physically Fit;
 - Fully vaccinated and;
 - with parental consent
- 3. The activity aims to enhance camaraderie, goodwill, sportsmanship, discipline, teamwork, and life skills values of student-athletes inherent in their participation in sports.
- 4. There will be a registration of One Thousand Pesos (**Php 1000.00**) per team (for team events) and Two Hundred pesos (**Php 200.00**) per athlete (for the individual event). The registration fee shall be utilized for certificates, medals, tarpaulins, sports supplies/materials, and other operational expenses of the Technical Working Group.
- 4. The registration fee can be charged from a donation/sponsor/personal account. However, meals, travel, and other costs of the athletes and coaches shall be charged from the school MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Teacher-participants in this training shall be granted service credits while, School head-participants shall be given compensatory overtime credit for their services rendered on Saturday/Sunday pursuant to paragraph 5.3 letter K of Joint Circular of the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) dated October 4, 2004.
