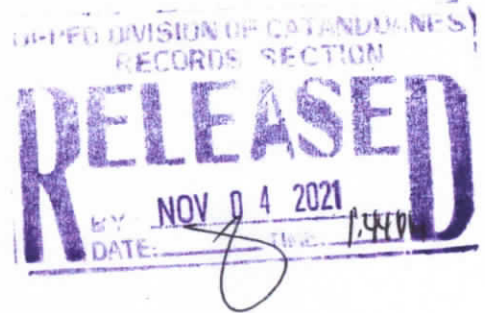

SUBJECT : SCHOOLS DIVISION of CATANDUANES: 2nd VACCINATION ROLL-OUT (2nd Doses)

1. The Schools Division Office of Catanduanes, under the Schools Governance and Operations Division, through the School Health and Nutrition Unit, will have its **Vaccination Roll-Out for Second Doses (SINOVAC)** on **November 3-6, 2021**, starting at 7 in the morning. This is in coordination with the Provincial Health Office, Department of Health Catanduanes and the Rural Health Unit of the municipality of Virac. As per the Office of the Governor's **Executive Order No. 037**, series **2021**, of **Adopting Guidelines for Areas placed under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine, Section 8** stated that gatherings that are essential for the provision of health services (example Vaccination) authorized by the appropriate government agency shall be allowed.

3. Guidelines from the 1st Roll-Out still remains as ***strict health protocols will be observed:***
 - No Facemask, No Entry;
 - Scheduled personnel must bring their own ballpens. Vaccination Cards and DepED IDs.
 - All attendees must be have no Flu-Like symptoms (fever, colds, cough, sorethroat, etc).
4. As the last day of inoculation falls on a Saturday, a Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) will be given to those mentioned above as well as the SDO Vaccination Team.
