effectiveness in the air medium. Pictures, charts, films, slides graphs, boards, music, etc. can all be employed in the techniques of teaching by TV. Also, television makes it possible for the talents of the best teachers to be put at the disposals of the schools.

3. At the end of the activity, participants are expected:

- a. To master the basics of operating video field equipment (camera, audio, lighting)
- b. To be able to use digital editing and multiple video elements together (images, sound, interviews, music, etc.) to achieve learning objectives in a lesson
- c. To feel confident in the basics of creating and overseeing a field production (pre-production, production , and direction)

4. Expected participants from all groups listed above will be a core team of five (5) members with the following qualifications:

- a. Four (4) members must be DepEd teaching or non-teaching personnel, including ALS teachers, with background and skills in any of the following: media arts, videography, photography, video editing, directing and writing.
- b. One (1) DepEd Teacher broadcaster, who has pleasing personality and with excellent oral and written communication skills. He or she is expected to ably write his/her own scripts.
