

Proposed Learning Continuity Plan

A. **ONLINE ENROLMENT** — The school Information Communication Technology(ICT) Coordinator will set-up an enrolment link(Google Forms) wherein students and parents could log-in to do the enrolment procedures. Pertinent papers for enrolment will be sent online and hardcopy to be submitted during the opening of classes. (This modality/mechanism is only good for those schools/districts with fast interconnection

B. **AUTOMATIC ENROLMENT** – This is automatic enrolment for Grades 2 to 6 (Elementary), Grades 8-10 (JHS) and Grade 11 and 12 (SHS) as stipulated in the guidelines for enrolment per DepEd Order No.41, s. 2012 and DepEd Order no. 3 s. 2018. The school have the ready records unless notified by parents for transferring out. Exemption to this mechanism are Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 7.

C. OTHER MODALITIES/MECHANISMS

- I. Kindergarten enrolment will be taken from the daycare teachers and private pre-schools thru online. Only those who will turn 5 years old as of June 1 to August 31, 2020 will be included in the list. Pre-Assessment of the PECD will be done by observing strict social distancing. Items which requires closer distance by the teachers to pupils shall not be assessed yet. This may be done if the situation is fully stable.
- II. Grade 7 teachers should coordinate with the Grade 6 advisers in their respective areas to get the list of the enrollees thru online submission.

- C. OTHER MODALITIES/MECHANISMS
- III. Enrolment may be done by schedules. One grade level per day. Big schools may have it by grade level and small schools by grade clustering (Grade 1 &2, 3&4, 5&6). Enrolment must be done in alphabetical order. Letters A to J will do first the procedures and J-Z will be second batch. Area for enrolment must be disinfected before it will used. Strict Observance of DOH Protocols and safety measures are the topmost priority.
- IV. Data on early registration done last January and February 2020 may be used as the baseline data for the prospective enrollees from Kindergarten to Grade 12.

C. OTHER MODALITIES/MECHANISMS

- IV. BANDILYO This is an old time practice but effective measures of information dissemination/advocacy during the enrolment period. School should coordinate with Barangay/LGUs for this purpose. The context of the information to be disseminated will be provided by the SDO for uniformity.
- V. ALS Learners Use the old list/data of learners. Mapping will be conducted if the situation in the community is fully stable.

- Face to face or modular: Non-digital hardcopies of books, modules

- Identify/assign independent learners in a locality, examinations be done in an identified place following social distancing.
- Identify frontliners in a barangay for distribution and help as regards offline or hardcopies
- Assistance of independent learners specially for assessment/evaluation purposes.
- For senior high school, proper scheduling of topics and discussions for specific track/strand
- Peer tutoring under the guidance of a teacher
- Google classroom instruction for those with internet connection

- Parent-child instruction and assistance
- Anchor lessons on specialization/strand for Senior HS
- Salient/essential competencies focus

- Flipped classroom/EdTech Tools, guided with the Blended approach and Modular approach
- Teachers could have team teaching, merging lessons into one and targeting many subjects in a lesson
- OHSP maybe considered for junior high school

 Take home lessons utilizing different learning materials from the classroom, downloaded materials from the LR and other learning modalities (modular approach, E-books, Deped Commons) with the cooperation of parents as the teacher at home. Output results could be submitted by the parents to the teacher for assessment. Follow up performance through parents. Reporting of parents to school could be scheduled. Teacher will follow up the progress of the students and give weekly assessment.
