## DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON COMPUTER HARDWARE SERVICING (CHS) (BATCH 1)

TO: Public Schools District Supervisors Secondary School Heads School ICT Teachers/Coordinators

- 1. Pursuant to Division Memorandum No. 58, s. 2014 re: School ICT Profile, this office will conduct a 7-day Training-Workshop on Basic Computer Hardware Servicing this September 5, 6, 7, 11,12,13 and 14, 2014 at **Division Office Conference Hall A.**
- 2. The objectives of this training are:
  - a) Equip the participants with knowledge and skills in Computer Hardware Servicing.
  - b) Broaden the teaching capabilities of teachers through integration of the CHS skills.
  - c) Provide basic troubleshooting techniques, diagnosis, minor repairs and maintain operational condition of computer system in their schools.
  - d) Obtain Computer Hardware Servicing National Certificate(NC) II
- 3. Participants to this training are Secondary ICT Coordinators/Teachers and Elementary ICT Coordinators of Virac Pilot Elem. School, Virac Central ES and JMAMES. **Trainers** are advised to be on the venue one day before the scheduled date to prepare the necessary materials and equipment to be used by the participants.
- 4. Participants are advised to bring the following materials:
  - a. 1 set Desktop Computer Unit with AVR or UPS
  - b. 1pc Philips head screw driver
  - c. 1 pc Flat head screw driver
  - d. 1 pc Long nose Pliers
  - e. Broadband
  - f. Extension Wire
- 5. A registration fee of Nine Hundred Pesos (Php 900.00) shall be charged each participant to cover hand –outs/CD burning, equipment and other consumable materials. Travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Meals and snacks of participants are not included in the registration fee.
