
- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 42, s. 2025, entitled 2025 Brigada Eskwela Implementing Guidelines and consistent with DepEd Order No. 012, s. 2025, entitled Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities, this Office enjoins all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and public schools in Region V to participate and conduct the 2025 Brigada Eskwela Program from June 9 to 13, 2025, as part of Department of Education's annual initiative to ensure schools are safe, resilient, and well-equipped for the opening of classes on June 16, 2025.
- 2. This year, Region V, through Albay Division, has been identified to host the National Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off Program on June 9, 2025, 8:00 in the morning at Bacacay East Central School, Bacacay, Albay. DepEd Central Office officials, Region V's regional and division officials, education partners and stakeholders, and selected school heads and teachers are expected to take part in this national activity.
- 3. The event will be streamed live on the official DepEd Philippines Facebook page to simultaneously launch and promote Brigada Eskwela.
- 4. Brigada Eskwela is a five-day activity that upholds the spirit of bayanihan, encouraging community collaboration to prepare schools for the upcoming school year. With literacy as a key priority of the Department, this year's theme, **Brigada Eskwela: Sama-sama Para sa Bayang Bumabasa**, highlights a nationwide effort and volunteerism on literacy development. The program also serves various purposes like the usual preparation and improvement of school facilities and environment, supporting the physical and mental well-being of learners, addressing the needs of engaging parents and stakeholders, and ensuring the accuracy of educational data through a nationwide inventory validation.
- 5. This year's *Brigada Eskwela* shall focus on the following:
 - ensuring that all schools are well-prepared for the new school year by providing a clean, safe, and conducive learning environment for both learners and teachers;
















- b. encouraging active participation of stakeholders in supporting learners' reading skills development and ensuring that reading resources are available at the schools.
- organizing clean-up activities and performing minor to medium repairs and maintenance work in classrooms and school grounds;
- d. promoting volunteerism and community involvement in enhancing school facilities and resources;
- e. creating a master list of learners along with a schedule for health assessments (e.g., nutritional assessment and vision and hearing screening) and assisting the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation in the enrollment of learners to the National Health Insurance Program;
- f. engaging stakeholders in mobilizing data-driven partnerships with the community to help address the needs of schools; and
- g. validating essential resource data against existing records of DepEd and engaging the community in establishing inventory data.
- 6. The guidelines on the implementation of Brigada Eskwela and National Inventory Day (NID) for School Year 2025–2026 are provided in Enclosures No. 1 and 2 of DepEd Memorandum No. 42, s. 2025. DepEd Policy and Planning Service under the Strategic Management Strand shall take the lead in the execution of the NID. On the other hand, the guidelines for the Learners' Health Assessment shall be issued by the School Health Division of DepEd Central Office.
- 7. A virtual orientation and planning conference with TWG, SGOD Chiefs and Division Brigada Eskwela Coordinators to discuss the Brigada Eskwela Implementing Guidelines will be held on **June 4, 2025**, 1:30 in the afternoon via MS Teams. The Meeting link will be shared to the concerned division personnel before the conduct of the online activity.
- 8. To ensure active participation of Schools Division Offices in the National Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off Program on June 9, 2025, and for smooth implementation of Brigada Eskwela, all SDOs are requested to guarantee the following:
 - a. All SDOs and public schools shall organize their Monitoring & Evaluation teams for Brigada Eskwela and to ensure the safety and security of learners for the opening of SY 2025-2026 through the implementation of Brigada Eskwela. Coordination with the proper authorities and partners/stakeholders to improve learning conditions must be carried out.
 - For the National Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off Program on June 9, 2025, each SDO will put up an exhibit at Bacacay East CS, Bacacay, Albay

















showcasing the division's good practices and initiatives aligned with the theme of Brigada Eskwela. Photos and descriptions of these initiatives must be printed on photo paper to be posted on the designated booth for the division. Albay Division will take charge of setting up the booths following a standard measurement. All preparations must be done from June 7 to 8, 2025. Each SDO is also requested to invite one major partner to set-up booth for the exhibit. The name of the partner must be submitted on or before May 26, 2025 to Division of Albay.

- 9. The Brigada Eskwela Caravan will be held on June 9, 2025, 7:00 in the morning. The assembly starts at 6:00 in the morning at Malilipot Central School. Every division will participate in the caravan with the following DepEd personnel: Schools Division Superintendent, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (ASDSs), SGOD Chiefs, CID Chiefs, SEPS and EPS for Social Mobilization and Networking. The Caravan will depart from Malilipot CS at 7:00 in the morning.
- 10. For DepEd Regional Office V, every functional division is enjoined to identify two personnel to join the National Brigada Eskwela Kick Off Program on June 9, 2025, at Malilipot Central School. They will make their own vehicle arrangement and prepare their respective travel authorities. Likewise, each functional division is encouraged to adopt and support at least one school within the Division of Albay during the Brigada Eskwela implementation from June 9-13, 2025. The list of the identified school/s must be submitted to ESSD before the actual visit to the identified school, for record purposes.

11. Select Regional and Division Officials will be assigned as Protocol Officers for several Executive Officials. They are:
