1. In alignment with the Department of Education's commitment to advancing the Senior High School (SHS) Program and pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 00667, s. 2026 (Advisory to Regional Memorandum No. 00615, s. 2026), this Office informs the field that the **Nationwide Work Immersion Fair** originally scheduled on May 14, 2026, has been officially re-scheduled to **September 11, 2026**. 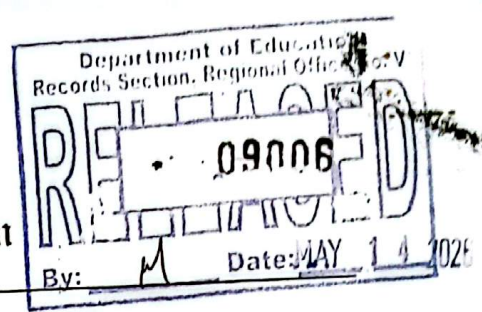

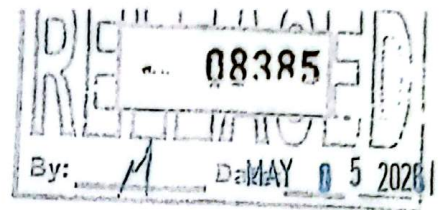

PARTICIPATION OF REGION V IN THE NATIONWIDE WORK IMMERSION FAIR

1. In alignment with the Department of Education's commitment to advancing the Senior High School (SHS) Program, a Nationwide Work Immersion Fair will be held on May 14, 2026. Organized in collaboration with government and industry partners, the event will highlight critical policy reforms, the revitalization of Tech-Voc education, and actionable insights from industry-led pilot programs. The work immersion fair aims to:
 - a. Ensure robust collaboration between schools and industry;
 - b. Obtain formal commitments from potential partner companies to host work immersion sessions for learners under the pilot Strengthened SHS Curriculum for S.Y. 2026-2027; and
 - c. Highlight the readiness of SHS learners for the workforce.
3. In cooperation with the nationwide initiative, **Region V** will host a simultaneous regional event on **May 14, 2026**, at **Camarines Sur National High School** on Peñafrancia Avenue, Naga City. The school was selected for its status as a Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program (STVEP) center and its role as a pilot implementer of the SHS TechPro (TVL) Track. Furthermore, its extensive industry network and capacity for large-scale gatherings make it the ideal venue for this launch.
4. All divisions are requested to confirm their participation by May 8, 2026. Participants are expected to arrive at the venue on the day of the activity. Meals (two snacks and lunch) will be served.
5. Operational expenses shall be charged to downloaded funds, while the travel expenses shall be charged against school MOOE, local funds, or other available sources, subject to standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations
6. The List of participants and the program of activities for the Regional Work Immersion Fair are enclosed for reference.
7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
